- 1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 24.7.2014 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as Regulations).
- 2. The applicant's case in brief is that he received excessive bill of June 2014 for 1094 units and requested to revise the bill. He filed grievance application to I.G.R.C. but is rejected. Therefore applicant approached to this Forum.

- 3. Non applicant denied applicant's case by filing reply dated 8.8.2014. It is submitted that meter is tested by acucheck on 30.6.2014 and it is found O.K. Grievance application be dismissed.
- 4. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused the record.
- 5. On 13.8.2014, it was ordered by the Forum that meter be tested in laboratory of M.S.E.D.C.L. and to submit meter testing report. Executive Engineer Testing Division (U), MSEDCL, Nagpur filed meter testing report Dt. 10.9.2014 on record to the effect that meter is O.K.
- 6. We have also perused photos of meter reading. Photo also shows same consumption as shown in CPL. Therefore consumption recorded by the meter is the consumption utilised by the applicant. Therefore bill can not be revised. Hence Forum proceeds to pass following order:-
