1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 28.7.2014 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as Regulations).

2. The applicant's case in brief is that since February 2014, he is receiving excessive bills and therefore bill be revised. His application is rejected by I.G.R.C. on 16.5.2014. Therefore he approached to this Forum.

3. Non applicant denied applicant's case by filing reply dated 8.8.2014. As per order of Learned I.G.R.C. meter is tested in the meter testing laboratory and it is found O.K. Application be dismissed.

4. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused the record.

5. As per order dated 16.5.2014, Learned I.G.R.C. directed SNDL to test the meter in meter testing laboratory. Accordingly, meter is tested in the laboratory. Meter testing report shows that meter is O.K. Spot inspection report Dt. 8.8.2014 shows sufficient connected load. Considering the CPL it appears that consumption recorded by the meter is the consumption utilised by the application. Grievance application deserves to be dismissed. Hence following order : -
