- 1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 16.6.2014 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as Regulations).
- 2. The applicant's case in brief is that she complained to SNDL regarding excessive bill. Accordingly her meter is replaced and tested in meter testing laboratory on 11.6.2014 and found O.K. But applicant is not satisfied with this report and therefore filed grievance application before I.G.R.C. to test the meter in the laboratory.

Learned I.G.R.C. passed the order dt. 12.6.2014. Being aggrieved by the said order the applicant filed present grievance application and requested to revise the bill.

- 3. Non applicant denied applicant's case by filing reply dated 1.7.2014. It is submitted that meter of the applicant was tested in the meter testing laboratory on 11.6.2014 and it is found O.K. Therefore grievance application may be dismissed.
- 4. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused the record.
- 5. We have perused meter testing report of the meter testing laboratory Dt. 11.6.2014. It is duly signed by the consumer. Meter is found O.K. There is also spot inspection report on record which shows that there are 7 rooms in the house of the applicant and sufficient connected load. Considering CPL of the applicant, connected load and meter testing report we find no force in the present grievance application and application deserves to be dismissed. Hence following order:-
