1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 10.9.2014 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as Regulations).

2. The applicant's case in brief is that applicant received excessive bills from April 2014. He applied for revision of bills but in vain. His application is rejected by I.G.R.C. Therefore he approached to this Forum.

3. Non applicant denied applicant's case by filing reply Dt. 26.9.2014. It is submitted that as per order of Learned I.G.R.C. old meter is replaced, new meter is installed and meter is tested in the laboratory of M/s. SNDL. It is found O.K. Therefore bills can not be revised.

4. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused the record.

5. Record shows that meter is tested by SNDL in its laboratory and it is found O.K. Therefore reading recorded by the meter is the consumption utilised by the applicant and hence bill can not be revised.

6. We find no substance & it deserves to be dismissed. Hence following order:-

1) Grievance application is dismissed.
