- 1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 11.9.2014 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as Regulations).
- 2. The applicant's case in brief is that since May 2014 applicant received excessive bills. He approached to I.G.R.C. but his application is rejected. Therefore he approached to this Forum.

- 3. Non applicant denied applicant's case by filing reply Dt. 26.9.2014. It is submitted that meter is tested by acucheck and it is found O.K. Connected load of the applicant is 2.6 kW and his average consumption is 585 units per month. Therefore bills are not excessive. Grievance application may be dismissed.
- 4. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused the record.
- of 710 units. However, it was summer season and therefore it can not be said that bill is excessive. Consumption depends upon use of electricity. In May 2014 also consumption of applicant was 481 units. In June 2012 also consumption is 483 units. In July 2012 consumption was 504 units. Therefore there is normal trend of consumption. Meter testing report Dt. 18.8.2014 shows that meter is tested and it is found O.K. Therefore bill can not be revised. Hence following order.

ORDER

1) Grievance application is dismissed.
