- 1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 24.9.2014 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as Regulations).
- 2. The applicant's case in brief is that he received excessive bills since April 2014. Being aggrieved by the order passed by I.G.R.C. he approached to this Forum.

- 3. Non applicant denied applicant's case by filing reply Dt. 4.10.2014. Bill issued by the non applicant is correct and proper. Bill can not be revised. Grievance application deserves to be dismissed.
- 4. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused the record.
- 5. We have carefully perused trend of consumption of the applicant since 2012 to 2014. There is same trend of consumption. There is sufficient load shown in spot inspection report. There are even 2 A.Cs. and 1 cooler. Due to late rainy season there was summer in June 2014 & July 2014. Therefore due to excess use it is but natural to have more consumption. Meter is tested by acucheck and it is found O.K. In our opinion there is no force in grievance application. Order passed by Learned I.G.R.C. is legal and proper and needs no interference. Grievance application deserves to be dismissed. Hence following order: -
