## ORDER PASSED ON 20.11.2014.

1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 30.9.2014 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as Regulations).

2. The applicant's case in brief is that he received excessive bills. Therefore bills be revised. His application is rejected by I.G.R.C. Therefore he approached to this Forum. Non applicant denied applicant's case by filing reply Dt.
10.10.2014. It is submitted that Meter was tested by acucheck and it is found O.K. Bill issued as per consumption and can not be revised.

4. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused the record.

5. During the course of arguments as per order dated 14.10.2014, it is ordered by this Forum that Meter No. 65/C1021799 be tested in the laboratory of M.S.E.D.C.L. and to submit meter testing report. Accordingly, Executive Engineer Testing Division (U), MSEDCL, Nagpur filed testing report on record to the effect that meter is O.K. Therefore consumption recorded by the meter is the consumption utilised by the applicant and hence bill can not be revised. As per spot inspection report there is heavy load. Applicant admitted that 2 families are residing in the house. Grievance application deserves to be dismissed. Hence following order : -

## ORDER

1) Grievance application is dismissed.
