- 1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 17.10.2014 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as Regulations).
- 2. The applicant's case in brief is that applicant received excessive bills from June 2014. Being aggrieved by the order of I.G.R.C. applicant approached to this Forum.

- 3. Non applicant denied applicant's case by filing reply Dt. 27.10.2014. It is submitted that meter was tested by acucheck on 9.8.2014 and it is found O.K. Grievance application be dismissed.
- 4. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused the record.
- Only in the month of April 2014, consumption is shown 343 units and in June 2014 440 units. However, it was the summer season and therefore it is possible to have excessive utilization of electricity. In all other months consumption is about 100 to maximum 187 units. Therefore there is similar trend of consumption. Sufficient load is shown in spot inspection report Dt. 22.10.2014. Meter is tested and it is found O.K. There bill can not be revised. Grievance application deserves to be dismissed. Hence following order:

1) Grievance application is dismissed.
