2. The applicants' case in brief is that since June 2013 applicant is receiving excessive bills. Meter was tested and found O.K. But applicant is not satisfied with that meter test. Bill may be revised and meter may be tested in the laboratory of M.S.E.D.C.L.

- 3. Non applicant M/s. SPANCO denied applicant's case by filing reply dt. 17.8.2013. It is submitted that meter of the applicant is tested by acucheck and it is found O.K. Grievance application may be dismissed.
- 4. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused the record.
- 5. We have carefully perused the entire record. Bill of June 2013 of 3521 units is bill for three months. In this bill M/s. SPANCO had already credit of Rs. 7759/-. We have carefully perused spot inspection report. It shows that applicant has following connected load:-

a) A.C.
b) Fan
c) Inverter
d) CFL
e) Computer
f) Tube Lights

Therefore there is sufficient consumption. This disputed bill is regarding summer season. Considering trend of consumption of the applicant, in our opinion, as the meter is already tested and found O.K., there is no need to test the meter again. Bill issued by non applicant is perfectly legal and correct and needs no interference. Hence Forum proceeds to pass following order: -
