ORDER PASSED ON 22.03.2017.

1. The Applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on dtd. 02.02.2017 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as said Regulations).
2. Applicant's case in brief is that he received excessive bill and therefore, bill may be

revised.

3. Non applicant denied the applicant's case by filling reply on dt. 18.02.2017. It is submitted that there is sufficient load. Meter is tested and it is found O.K. Grievance application deserves to be dismissed.

3. Forum heard arguments of both the side and perused record.

4. As per order dt. 28.02.2017 this forum had ordered to test the meter in the lab of MSEDCL and to submit report. Accordingly meter of the applicant is tested in the lab of MSEDCL and as per meter testing report dt. 17.03.2017 issued by Executive Engineer, Urban Testing Division, MSEDCL, Nagpur meter is O.K.

5. Furthermore there is sufficient load, therefore, it is but natural to have more consumption. There is similar trend of consumption. As the meter is O.K. there is no scope for the revision of bill. Grievance application deserves to be dismissed.

6. Therefore Forum proceed to pass the following order.
