3. Forum heard arguments of both the side and perused record.

4. As per order dtd. 28.02.2017 passed by this forum it was directed to test the meter in the lab of MSEDCL and to submit report. Accordingly meter of the applicant is tested in the lab of MSEDCL and as per meter testing report dtd. 17.03.2017 issued by Executive Engineer, Urban Testing Division, MSEDCL, Nagpur meter is O.K.
