ORDER PASSED ON 5.8.2014.

1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 1.7.2014 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as Regulations).

2. The applicant's case in brief is that he is receiving excessive bills. His meter was replaced and tested in meter testing laboratory on 12.6.2014 and declared O.K. but he is not satisfied. Therefore the applicant approached to I.G.R.C. Being aggrieved by the order of Learned I.G.R.C. he approached to this Forum. Non applicant denied applicant's case by filing reply dated 18.7.2014. It is submitted that meter is tested and it is found O.K. Grievance application be dismissed.

4. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused the record.

5. Applicant argued that 2 separate families are residing in this premises. Family of the applicant and family of his brother are residing in this premises. There are 5 rooms. Spot inspection report shows sufficient load. Meter is tested and it is found O.K. Considering the entire record, in our opinion, order passed by Learned I.G.R.C. is correct and needs no interference.

ORDER

1) Grievance application is dismissed.
