Sub: Implementation of Pilot Scheme in respect of PWW consumers.

The Government of Maharashtra has decided to give a relief in payment of energy bills to rural PWW consumers by way of implementation of a Pilot scheme. The scheme will be implemented jointly by MSEDCL and Jeevan Pradhikaran Department of GoM. The Pilot scheme will be implemented for all the rural PWW consumers in Satara District and 12 Regional Water Works Schemes from Six Revenue Divisions of Jeevan Pradhikaran [i.e. 2 Schemes from each Revenue Divisions]. The details of scheme are as under:

- The current bills of rural PWW consumers (those who are included in scheme) from dated 01.01.2012 will be partly paid by the GoM. As per the scheme, the rural PWW consumers shall pay 60% of current bill within due date and on payment of same the GoM will pay remaining 40% of current bill to MSEDCL.
- For the implementation of scheme, the GoM will pay Rs. 162 Lakhs to MSEDCL through Jeevan Pradhikaran on completion of required formalities
- MSEDCL will carry out required programming and changes in IT software to that extent.

Since the scheme is beneficial to MSEDCL, the matter was submitted to "Board" in meeting dated 07.03.2012 for decision. The Board vide Resolution No. 50 dated 07.03.2012 has granted approval for Implementation of Pilot Scheme in respect of PWW consumers as under:

- 1) The scheme is to be implemented for PWW consumers as specified by Jeevan Pradhikaran and the consumers in arrears shall also be eligible to the said scheme.

- 2) The amount paid by the consumers covered under this scheme shall be adjusted first in current bills to the extent of amount payable by them under this scheme.
- 3) The consumer under this scheme shall be approached by MSEDCL for payment of arrears as on dated 31.12.2011, but their supply shall not be disconnected till such time that the consumer is covered in this scheme.

The Board further directed that the above said pilot scheme shall be reviewed in July 2012.

All the field officers are hereby instructed to follow the guidelines and take further necessary action as per decision of the Board.
