ORDER PASSED ON 28.07.2016.

- 1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 02.07.2016 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as said Regulations).
- 2. Non applicant, denied applicant's case by filing reply dated 15.07.2016.

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- 3. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused record.
- 4. In application before IGRC it was simply complaint of the applicant that bill for July-2015 was excessive. Learned IGRC allowed grievance application and directed SNDL to revise the bill of July-2015 (for 3 months) considering the monthly average of 360 units and give credit of balance units and further order to revise bill of October-2015 for 3 months for 1222 units and give credit of balance units. It was also ordered that above total credit alongwith credit of DPC interest should be given in the issuing bill.
- 5. Accordingly bill of the applicant was revised. Credit of Rs.16597.76 p.s. is given to the applicant in December-2015.
- 6. We have carefully perused connected load of the applicant. There are 6 rooms and 2 families are residing. There is sufficient connected load. Considering connected load and consumption of the applicant in our opinion order passed by the learned IGRC is legal and proper.
- 7. Record shows that applicant issued the cheque of Rs.30,000/- on 31-05-2016 for payment of electricity bill but cheque was dishonoured and it was bounced. Last date of payment is on 14-05-2016 Rs.15000/- and since 14-05-2016 applicant did not pay any electricity bill and enjoying electricity on credit. It is not legal and proper.
- 8. Order passed by learned IGRC is legal and proper and needs no interference and therefore grievance application deserves to be dismissed.
- 9. Hence the following order.

ORDER

1 Grievance application is dismissed.
