1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 05.07.2016 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as said Regulations).

- 2. Non applicant, denied applicant's case by filing reply dated 29.07.2016.
- 3. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused record.

4. It is noteworthy that applicant approached to learned IGRC and in case No.1006/2016. IGRC has allowed grievance application of the applicant as per order dated 24-05-2016 and directed to MSEDCL to release the connection of the applicant and pay compensation according to schedule 'A' of MERC's SOP Regulation. Therefore application of the applicant is allowed by learned IGRC and not rejected. Regulation 6.2 of the said Regulation is the provision for filing the application before IGRC. If IGRC did not redressed the grievance of the applicant then only applicant can file application to this forum under Regulation 6.4 of the said Regulation. In this case grievance application under Regulation 6.4 of the said Regulation is not tenable and it can not be register even.

5. According to applicant MSEDCL did not comply order of IGRC and therefore he approached to this forum. But this CGRF is not executing authority to execute orders of IGRC. If MSEDCL did not obey orders of IGRC in that case applicant is at liberty to file contempt proceeding against MSEDCL under section 142 of The Electricity Act 2003 to Hon'ble MERC. Therefore present grievance application is not tenable at law before this forum.

6. Mr. John Koshi, Junior Engineer argued that as per order of IGRC connection is given on 06-06-2016. Applicant gave in writing that applicant don't want any compensation as per order of IGRC. We have perused application of the applicant dated 06-06-2016 it shows that applicant had given in writing that he don't want any compensation as per IGRC order. There is signature of the applicant on application. We find no force in grievance application and application deserves to be dismissed. Hence, following order.

ORDER

1. Grievance application is dismissed.
