1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 25.5.2015 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal

- 2. Applicant's case in brief is that his meter is changed in October 2014 and since then bill is excessive. Therefore bill may be revised.
- 3. Non applicant denied applicant's case by filing reply Dated 10.7.2015. It is submitted that meter is tested in the laboratory on 11.5.2015 and found O.K. Grievance application deserves to be dismissed.
- 4. Forum heard the arguments of both the sides and perused the record.
- 5. Meter of the applicant is tested in the laboratory of SNDL and it is found O.K. Therefore consumption utilized by the applicant is correctly recorded by the meter.
