ORDER PASSED ON 22.7.2015.

1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 6.6.2015 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal

Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as said Regulations).

2. Applicant's case in brief is that he received excessive bills. Therefore bills be revised Being aggrieved by the order passed by I.G.R.C. he approached to this Forum.

3. Non applicant denied applicant's case by filing reply Dated 16.6.2015. It is submitted that Learned I.G.R.C. passed order dated 22.5.2015 and ordered to revise the bill. Accordingly SNDL will comply. Grievance application deserves to be dismissed.

4. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused the record.

5. Bills for the period November 2014 to February 2015 are disputed. Meter is replaced in March 2015. As per order of Learned I.G.R.C. 12 months average is calculated, bills are revised and credit of Rs. 20465/- is given in April 2015.

6. We have carefully perused inspection report. CPL shows that in November 2014 and December 2014, there was 'faulty' status. In January 2015 and February 2015 there was 'faulty' status. All these aspects are duly considered by Learned I.G.R.C. in its detailed order Dt. 22.5.2015 and directions are given to revise the bill as per specifications given in the order. Accordingly SNDL had revised bill considering 12 months average and given credit of Rs. 20465.51 to the applicant in April 2015. In

our opinion order passed by Learned I.G.R.C. is legal and proper and needs no interference. Grievance application deserves to be dismissed. Hence following order :-
