1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 17.7.2015 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as said Regulations).

2. Applicant's case in brief is that he is receiving excessive bills. Being aggrieved by the order passed by I.G.R.C. he approached to this Forum.

3. Non applicant denied applicant's case by filing reply Dated 4.8.2015. It is submitted that meter is tested in meter testing laboratory on 24.6.2015 and found O.K. Therefore bills can not be revised.

4. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused record.

5. Main grievance of the applicant is for bill of May 2015 for 1409 units. During the course of arguments, applicant admitted that adjacent to the residential house, there is shop of the applicant. It is the shop of daily needs like storages of Ice creams, utilization of freeze etc. Meter of the applicant is tested in the laboratory of SNDL and it is found O.K. Therefore consumption utilized by the applicant is correctly recorded by the meter. Further more, it is summer season. In our opinion, there is no scope for revision of the bill and grievance application deserves to be dismissed. Hence following order:-

ORDER

1) Grievance application is dismissed.
