**ORDER PASSED ON 11.9.2015.**

1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 11.8.2015 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as Regulations).

2. Applicants case in brief is that only in May 2015, he received excessive consumption of 750 units, which needs to be revised.

3. Non applicant denied applicants case by filing reply dated 25.8.2015. It is submitted that old meter is replaced, new meter is installed, old meter is tested in the laboratory in presence of the applicant and found O.K. Therefore bills can not be revised.

4. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused the record.

5. We have carefully perused CPL in February 2015. There was Inaccessible status and average billing was done for 156 units, March 2015 - 576 units, April 2015 – 202 units, but in May 2015 – 750 units. Considering the consumption trend of the applicant it appears that bill of May 2015 for 750 units is excessive. It appears that it is the billing of April 2015 and May 2015 and therefore it is necessary to revise the bill on average basis of preceding 12 months and to revise the bill of April 2015 & May 2015. Hence the order : -

### ORDER

- 1) Grievance application is partly allowed.
- 2) Non applicant is hereby directed to revise the bill of the applicant for the month of April 2015 and May 2015 considering average of preceding 12 months.
- 3) Compliance should be reported within 30 days from the date of this order.
