ORDER PASSED ON 11.12.2014.

1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 27.10.2014 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as Regulations).

2. The applicant's case in brief is that he received excessive bills from July 2014 and therefore bills be revised. Being aggrieved by the order passed by I.G.R.C. he approached to this Forum.

3. Non applicant denied applicant's case by filing reply Dt. 13.11.2014. It is submitted that Learned I.G.R.C. has passed legal and proper order and that order is fully complied. Grievance application deserves to be dismissed.

4. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused the record.

5. We have carefully perused order passed by Learned I.G.R.C. in Case No. 726/14 Dt. 22.9.2014. It is well reasoned and speaking order. Proper calculations are made and grievance of the applicant is fully redressed. Commercial Manager of SNDL is directed to revise applicants bill from May 2014 to August 2014 by bifurcating his total consumption of 571 units in 4 months and to give credit accordingly to him in his ensuing bill. Therefore said order passed by Learned I.G.R.C. is legal and proper and needs no interference. Simply it is necessary to comply order passed by Learned I.G.R.C. Hence following order.

ORDER

- 1) Grievance application is partly allowed.
- 2) Non applicant is hereby directed to comply order passed by Learned I.G.R.C. Dt. 22.9.2014 in case No. 726/14.
- 3) Compliance should be reported within 30 days from the date of this order.
