ORDER PASSED ON 28.10.2015.

1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 5.10.2015 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as said Regulations).

2. Applicant's case in brief is that he received excessive bills. Being aggrieved by the order passed by I.G.R.C. he approached to this Forum.

3. Non applicant denied applicant's case by filing reply Dated 21.10.2015. It is submitted that meter was tested in the laboratory on 28.8.2015 and it is found O.K. Grievance application deserves to be dismissed.

4. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused record.

5. According to the applicant his consumption since May 2015 to September 2015 is excessive but we have compared this consumption with past consumption trend of the applicant. It is noteworthy that in May 2014 also consumption was 1417 units. In July 2014 consumption was 1160 units. Therefore there is same trend of consumption. Spot inspection report shows that there is heavy load and applicant is using two A.Cs., Video Games, Sound System, C.C. TV Camera, Gas Chimany. Representative of the applicant argued that applicant is builder. Considering the connected load, consumption is normal.

6. During the course of arguments Forum made enquiry to the representative of the applicant Shri Sunil Nandanwar whether applicant is willing to test the meter in the laboratory of M.S.E.D.C.L. and if yes, Forum is ready to pass order for meter

testing accordingly. But representative of the applicant told that meter is tested in his presence by M.S.E.D.C.L. and it is O.K. Now he has no desire to test the meter in the laboratory of M.S.E.D.C.L. Therefore no such order was passed.

7. Meter is tested in the laboratory of S.N.D.L. and it is found O.K. Therefore bill can not be revised. Grievance application deserves to be dismissed. Hence following order

ORDER

- 1) Grievance application is dismissed.
