1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 24.09.2015 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as said Regulations).

2. Applicant's case in brief is that he received excessive bills for the month of May 2015 and June 2015 therefore requested to revise the bills. He approached to I.G.R.C. Being aggrieved by the order passed by Learned I.G.R.C. he approached to this Forum.

3. Non applicant, denied applicant's case by filing reply dated 09.10.2015. It is submitted that old meter replaced, new meter is installed. Old meter is tested in meter is testing laboratory of SNDL and it is found O.K. Therefore bills can not be revised.

4. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused record.

5. Meter testing report dated 05-08-2015 shows that meter was tested in the laboratory of SNDL and found O.K. During the course of arguments it was ordered by forum on dated 13.10.2015 that meter be tested in the laboratory of MSEDCL. Accordingly meter is tested in the laboratory of MSEDCL. As per meter testing report dated 04-11-2015 issued by Executive Engineer, Urban Testing Division, MSEDCL, Nagpur meter is O.K. Therefore bill can not be revised.

6. We find no reason to interfere in the order of Learned I.G.R.C. There is no scope for revision of the bill and grievance application deserves to be dismissed. Hence forum proceed to pass the following order :-
