1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 6.12.2014 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as Regulations).

2. Applicant's case in brief is that he received excessive bills. Being aggrieved by the order passed by I.G.R.C. Dt. 30.8.2014 he approached to this Forum. 3. Non applicant denied applicant's case by filing reply Dt. 22.12.2014. It is submitted that as per order passed by I.G.R.C. meter is tested in the laboratory of SNDL on 1.12.2014 and it is found O.K. Grievance application be dismissed.

4. Forum heard argument of non applicant and perused record.

5. In the month of July 2014, consumption is shown 1275 units. Considering the connected load on record, it is crystal clear that the meter jumped in July 2014 and therefore it is necessary to revise the bill of the applicant for July 2014 on average basis of preceding three months consumption. Hence following order : -

ORDER

- 1) Grievance application is partly allowed.
- 2) Non applicant shall revise the bill of the applicant for July 2014 on average basis of preceding three months consumption.
- 3) Compliance should be reported within 30 days from the date of this order.
