2. Non applicant, denied applicant's case by filing reply dated 15.02.2016.

3. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused record.

4. We perused order of IGRC dated 05-01-2016. IGRC directed to revise the bills from March-2015 to September-2015 considering monthly consumption of 385 units. Accordingly bill of the applicant is already revised and credit of Rs.19011.54 p.s. is given in the month of January-2016.

5. There is sufficient load. Considering connected load, IGRC given average bill of 385 units p.m. and credit is given.

6. Spot inspection report is doubtful. Applicant admitted in the Forum that there are 5 Rooms but only 4 Rooms are shown in inspection report. Applicant admitted that there are 4 Fans but only 3 Fans are shown in inspection report. Therefore employee of SNDL named Shri Sachin who is signatory had prepared bogus and false spot inspection report.

7. Considering the record, grievance of the applicant is fully redressed. Grievance application deserves to be dismissed.
