- 4. We have carefully perused order passed by learned IGRC. IGRC hold that meter is declared faulty therefore directed to revise the bill for consumption period at the average of 300 units and remaining period of 240 units. We have calculated connected load. As per our calculation the consumption of load of applicant on average consumption of 293 units per month. But IGRC has considered the consumption 300 units per month in summer season and 240 units per month in remaining part. Therefore order passed by IGRC is legal and proper and needs no interference. Grievance application is deserves to be dismissed.
