1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 28.01.2015 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as Regulations).

2. Applicant's case in brief is that he received excessive bill of November 2014. Being aggrieved by the order passed by I.G.R.C. applicant approached to this Forum.

3. Non applicant denied applicant's case by filing reply Dt. 11.2.2015. It is submitted that Learned I.G.R.C. has rejected the application

as per order Dt. 12.1.2015. There is no force in the grievance application and it deserves to be dismissed.

4. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused the record.

5. As per order Dt. 12.2.2015, it was ordered by this Forum that meter be tested in the laboratory of M.S.E.D.C.L. and to submit meter testing report. Accordingly, Executive Engineer, Testing Division (U), MSEDCL, Nagpur tested the meter and filed meter testing report Dt. 17.2.2015 on record to the effect that meter is O.K. Therefore bill can not be revised. Hence the following order : -
