## ORDER PASSED ON 24.3.2015.

- 1. The applicant filed present grievance application before this Forum on 27.2.2015 under Regulation 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as Regulations).
- 2. Applicant's case in brief is that he is receiving excessive bills. Therefore bills be revised.
- 3. Non applicant denied applicants case by filing reply Dt. 9.3.2015. It is submitted that meter of the applicant is tested by acucheck on 17.7.2014 and it is found O.K. Meter reading was noted incorrect in April 2014. Therefore slab benefit was given to the applicant in the month

of April 2014 & May 2014 and amount of Rs. 3656.29 is given credit to the applicant in the bill of December 2014. As per order passed by Learned I.G.R.C. Dt. 29.10.2014, old meter is replaced, new meter is installed and old meter is tested in the laboratory of SNDL on 15.11.2014 and it is found O.K.

- 4. Forum heard arguments of both the sides and perused the record.
- 5. In May 2014, consumption is shown as1180 units and in July 2014 893 units for two months. Record shows that slab benefit of Rs. 3656.29 is already given to the applicant. No much relief can be given to the applicant. Meter is tested in the laboratory and it is found O.K. Therefore bill can not revised. Grievance application deserves to be dismissed. Hence following order:

## **ORDER**

1) Grievance application is dismissed.
