Applicant Shri Jatinderpal Singh Padam presented this grievance application under provisions of Regulation 6.4 of the MERC (CGRF & EO) Regulations 2006. According to the applicant electricity bills given to him for the month from June 2017 to November 2017 were improper and excessive. He approached the IGRC – SNDL Nagpur. However his request was dismissed by an order passed in case no. 89/2018 on 20-03-2018.

The respondent submitted parawise reply. The case was fixed for personal hearing on 26-04-2018. Both the parties were present. They were heard.

The applicant repeated the same facts submitted before the IGRC.

According to him the bills from May 2017 till the meter was changed were excessive. He requested for revision of those bills.

The respondent stated that after the receipt of complaint from the applicant the meter was changed. It was tested in the meter testing lab on 14-9-17. As per the report the meter was working properly.

To get the accuracy of the meter confirmed once again the parties were directed to get the meter tested. The respondent may take appropriate action as per the testing report. The application is partly allowed.
