ORDER (ORAL)

(DELIVERED ON 27.11.2019)

1. The Applicant through her representative Shri B.V. Betal approached this Forum under Para 6.4 of the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (Consumer Grievances Redressal Forum & Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations 2006, since her request for grant of electric connection for 3HP agricultural pump in her field property is not favorably considered and hence seek compensation also to the extent of Rs.50,000/-. On notice the NonApplicant by reply dated 25.11.2019 denied the claim.

2. Today when the matter is called out for final hearing, applicant's representative Shri B.V. Betal is present. On behalf of Non-applicant Shri M.S. Gadigone, Dy. Executive Engineer, assisted by Shri A.H. Wankhede, Assistant Engineer, Samudrapur Sub Dn., MSEDCL are present.

3. Oral submissions of both the parties heard. We have carefully perused the case record.

4. The claim is for compensation for failing to provide electric supply to the 3HP Agricultural pump by conventional mode. The record shows that the applicant applied on 03.07.2018, Demand Note issued on 08.07.2018 & applicant credited amount on 25.07.2018. However, he failed to submit Test Report to facilitate the Non-applicant to take further steps for laying HT line for a distance of 0.24 km i.e. 4 poles. When approached, the IGRC vide order dated 29.07.2019 directed applicant of submit Test Report. Instead of complying the said order, the applicant approached this forum when Test Report is still to be submitted.

5. The grievance application stands dismissed as untenable/premature, however, with a direction to the applicant to submit Test Report within two weeks. On its submission necessary steps be taken by the Non-applicant for releasing the Agricultural Pump Connection, to applicant in her field as per rules. This being so, there is no question of granting any compensation to applicant as sought, since she herself is at fault in not submitting the Test Report so far, for the reasons best known to her.

6. Parties are, however, directed to bear their respective cost of this proceedings.

7. Office to forward authenticate copy of this order to both the parties at the earliest for taking appropriate steps in the matter.
