Corrigendum IV to Commercial Circular No:320

Sub: Power Supply to individual entrepreneurs coming under one premise for Textile and Non Textile consumers - Corrigendum thereof.

Commercial Circular 320 dated 19.07.2019 was issued for providing Power Supply to individual entrepreneurs coming under one premise for Textile and Non Textile consumers.

Corrigendum-I was issued to Commercial Circular No.320 dated 19.07.2019 by Circular No 328 Dt 30.07.2020, in which this circular was made applicable to all categories HT/LT Consumers under one premise through multipartite agreement.

Corrigendum-II was issued to Commercial Circular No.320 dated 19.07.2019 by Circular No 345 Dt 01.08.2024, in which this circular was made applicable to Retail Gas Filling Stations, Petrol Pumps & Service Stations along with restaurant, rest rooms, convenience stores, etc, if any as Main Consumer with Commercial Category and Electric Vehicle Charging Station as Secondary Consumer with Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Stations tariff.

Corrigendum-III was issued to Commercial Circular No.320 dated 19.07.2019 by Commercial circular no. 347 dated 03.01.2025 in which this circular was made applicable to all consumers including Textile, Non textile, Retail Gas Filling Stations, Petrol Pumps & Service Stations in r/o HT or LT consumers with maximum allowable group load for textile and non textile consumers was below 2 MVA subject to technical feasibility along with the restricted no of consumers in a group for textile and non textile consumers was up to 250 Nos of consumers. Also, the main Consumer for textile and non textile groups, for group of LT consumer was specified in the circular. The consideration of Demand Charges, Energy Charges was also clarified in the circular.

Now considering the processing of applications for granting Multiparty connections where the total Contracted load exceeds 2 MVA, including that of the Principal consumer and in respect of Existing Multiparty Consumers having Contracted load above 2 MVA, this corrigendum IV is issued.

Accordingly, in order to maintain uniformity and consistency in processing such cases, it is proposed that Multiparty group connections having total contracted load exceeding 2 MVA may be considered, subject to strict compliance with the provisions stipulated in the Infrastructure Development Policy Circular ED (Dist-II)/M-I/NSC-Guidelines/35530 dated 14.11.2024 for sanctioning of load & requirement of land accordingly and its amendments time to time.

The above provisions shall be made applicable uniformly to both new and existing Multiparty groups seeking sanction or enhancement of contracted load.

All other terms and conditions specified in commercial Circular No. 320 will remain unchanged. All field officers are directed to take needful actions as per above guidelines issued.
