Commercial Circular.353 dated 04.03.2026 was issued for providing Power Supply to individual entrepreneurs coming under one premise for Textile and Non Textile consumers.

The following amendment in the Commercial Circular no. 353 is as below:-

Accordingly, in order to maintain uniformity and consistency in processing such cases, it is proposed that Multiparty group connections having total contracted load exceeding 2 MVA may be considered, subject to strict compliance with the provisions stipulated in the Infrastructure Development Policy Circular ED (Dist-II)/M-1/NSC-Guidelines/35530 dated 14.11.2024 for sanctioning of load & requirement of land accordingly and its amendments time to time	It is hereby clarified that upper load limit for sanctioning multiparty group connections has been removed. However while sanctioning load in case of multiparty group connections, it should be ensured that the developer/consumer should provide land for new substations mentioned in Circular-ED(Dist-II)/M-1/NSC-Guidelines/35530 dated 14.11.2024 and amendments thereof from time to time. All terms & Conditions in respect of load sanction shall be applicable as per the aforesaid circular

All other terms and conditions specified in commercial Circular No. 320 shall remain unchanged. All field officers are directed to take needful actions as per above guidelines issued.
